Her play Special was published and featured in CBC Gem and Obsidian Theatre's 21 Black Futures, which received the Canadian Screen Award for Best Web Program or Series.

Arts Commons, and Jube School, Keshia is
dedicated to empowering youth and
uplifting diverse communities through the
arts. In recognition of this work, she
received the 2025 Duval Lang Theatre for
Young Audiences Award.

Creator/Performer/Co-Producer

Born and raised in the Philippines, Bianca Miranda is a queer, Filipino performer, playwright, and producer, grateful to be living and working in Moh'kins'tsis, Treaty 7 Territory. She is the Producer at Downstage.

As a theatre-maker and playwright, their works most often start from a personal place and examine the intersections of her identities, born out of the necessity to tell underrepresented stories. She is the writer of "Kisapmata" (2023/2024 Betty Mitchell Award for Outstanding New Play; Chromatic Theatre & Lunchbox Theatre)

As an actor and performer, they've worked with theatre companies across the city, with some personal favourites such as Hamlet Frequency (Shakespeare Company and One Yellow Rabbit), Little Red (Major Matt Mason and Ghost River Theatre), and Timmy, Tommy, and the Haunted Hotel (Pape & Taper).

Reckoning, a play about the effects of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission, was a collaborative effort by Beagan and Moro, and is credited to **ARTICLE 11. Other A11 projects include** an extensive tour of Beagan's Deer Woman, designed and directed by Moro, to New Zealand, Australia, and the Edinburgh Festival. Moro is a multiaward winner and nominee and has twice been named among Toronto's NOW magazine's Top-10 theatre artists.
